He is also is vice chair of the Ohio River Way, and leader of the Nature Based Recreation Working Group with the Plan for the Ohio River Basin 2020-2025. He serves on the River City Paddle Sports, and the Salt River Watershed Watch boards to promote paddlesport safety, education, citizen science and the enhancement of the Ohio River and our urban water ways.
